(as amended by the P.A. of the Council 19 September 2016)

1. Definition and scope of the By-Laws:

Membershi

2. The members of the committee are limited.

3. All members of the committee are members of the committee and agree to abide by the Code of Professional Conduct of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police.

4. The members of the committee shall be elected by the members of the committee and shall include the following classes of members: a majority of members shall be elected by the Council:

(1) Fell

(2) Honorary Fell

(3) Member

(4) Honorary Member

(5) Associate

(6) Affiliate class of members a majority of which shall be elected by the Council

5. Fell members are eligible to become members of the FCIL, Members of the MCIL and Associates of the ACIL.

6. Fell and Members and members of the Council shall be voting members.

7. No members of the committee shall be eligible for the highest office of members of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police unless he has held the highest office of members of the committee.

8. The Council may appoint a Honorary Fell and Honorary Member of the committee if it is satisfied that he has rendered distinguished service to the committee and the RCMP. Honorary Fell and Honorary Member may be eligible to become members of the FCIL and the MCIL respectively.

9. No individual shall be eligible for election by the Council, if he is not a member of the committee. 06TD0005la 2g c
